Search four centuries of *Hamlet* quotations in context – a completely new kind of evidence for the cultural position held by Shakespeare and his language.

- quotations by 3312 authors from different periods, languages and genres.
- a core collection of 8731 quotations (and growing), attached to the lines they refer to.
- a complete collection of 10052 entries (and growing), including indirect references, vague anonymous traces and even earlier occurrences of phrases found in *Hamlet*.

- **Contribute your finds**
- **Use the software to build a database of your own.**
