Submission Process

Authors may submit their proposals until 24 March 2024. Submissions by young academic talents are especially encouraged. All submissions will undergo a peer-review process, and accepted papers will be included in the event proceedings – Authors will be notified of acceptance on 30 April 2024.

- Proposals should include name, affiliation of authors and co-authors, an abstracts, and three keywords. Abstracts should not exceed:
 - 200 words for Talks
 - 100 words for Book Presentations
 - 500 words for Workshops
- Proposals should be submitted as a single PDF document.
