

The Faculty of Arts and Humanities at Friedrich Schiller University Jena seeks to fill a

## Professorship (W3, or W2 with Tenure Track to W3) in Classical Philology ("Klassische Philologie") with a specialisation in Latin Studies ("Latinistik")

from April 1st, 2025.

As a member of the Institute for Classics, the future holder of the position (m/f/d) should represent the subject of Latin language and literature of Antiquity in its entirety in research and teaching and is supposed to have excellent domestic and international credentials within central areas of the subject. In addition, at least one research focus on the imperial period or late antiquity is desirable.

We expect the candidate to display high-quality teaching attitude, demonstrable experience in successful thirdparty funding, leadership skills, and high-ranking publication activities. The applicant should have visible networks and contacts in the domestic and international research community.

Willingness to cooperate in the interdisciplinary research priorities and research activities of the university, to participate in university self-administration and to cooperate with Thuringian institutions in research and teaching is expected. In particular, the willingness to cooperate in the DFG Graduate School (Graduiertenkolleg) 2792 "Autonomy of Heteronomous Texts in Antiquity and the Middle Ages" is a prerequisite.

Future tasks include committed teaching activities in high school teachers' training in Latin, in the BA and MA programs BA in Classics ("Altertumswissenschaften"), MA Greek and Latin Philology ("Griechische und Lateinische Philologie (Antike bis Humanismus)"), and MA Literary Translation in Theory and Practice ("Literarisches Übersetzen in Theorie und Praxis"). All classes are taught in German.

To be eligible for the position, candidates must hold a relevant doctorate, a Habilitation or equivalent academic achievement, as well as pedagogical aptitude in the field of Classical Philology ("Klassische Philologie") with a specialisation in Latin Studies ("Latinistik"). In case of a candidate's first professorial appointment, the appointment is intended to be initially on the W2 level and limited to six years; the transition to a W3 professorship without renewed job announcement is based on a positive tenure evaluation, at the latest after six years.

Friedrich Schiller University Jena aims to increase the proportion of women in research and teaching and therefore strongly encourages suitably qualified female academics to apply. Severely disabled persons will be given preferential consideration in case of equal suitability.
